Fine Arts students are encouraged and invited to apply for a Silo Gallery internship. Opportunity to work within the gallery, help further develop our Skitch Henderson museum and manage a major project will be available.

Purpose: Support the gallery and museum while fulfilling educational requirements.

Responsibilities: Participate in all preliminary and physical aspects regarding the installation of work to be exhibited. Complete one major project in art gallery or music museum. Spring/fall interns work 9 hrs/ week, 90 hrs per semester. Summer interns work 15 hrs/ week for 8-10 weeks.

Requirements: Interested students must complete the application, pass through an interview process, and submit an official transcript. In addition, two letters of recommendation need to be sent directly to the gallery.

Assistance will be provided to maintain a journal of your work experience which includes documentation of work produced during internship. A self-evaluation statement and letter from gallery director will be presented to educational institution at conclusion of program.

Opportunities: Curatorial, development, design, installation, education and marketing.
